



NTYFA Zero Tolerance Policy

NTYFA has a zero tolerance policy for unsportsmanlike conduct as defined as profanity toward players, coaches, and officials, as well as opposing team spectators, coaches and players. NTYFA also has a zero tolerance policy regarding taunting as defined as making remarks to provoke or challenge someone with insulting remarks such as heckling, mocking, teasing, poke fun or making fun of someone. Home and visitor team spectators must stay in designated area. Please stay off the fence to allow others behind you to see the game. No alcohol is permitted on premises or on person. These rules are mandated by NTYFA and violation may result in fines, ejections and/or suspensions.
